

LEAPO Grant Guidelines (FY 2022-2023)

Due Date: Saturday, November 5, 2022

1. The maximum amount to be awarded is \$750 and will be subject to board approval.
2. Only one submission per legally constituted subdivision will be accepted. The grant application should be submitted by an **active** representative on the LEAPO Board of Directors from the subdivision applying for the grant.
3. Requests must be submitted using LEAPO's grant application form which may be obtained from a LEAPO representative or LEAPO's website.
4. All submissions must be **submitted by mail** and must be **postmarked** on or before the due date **(November 5th, 2022)**. Applications postmarked after the due date will not be accepted.
5. Applications submitted by email, by hand, or after the due date will not be accepted and will be returned to the subdivision.
6. Applicants are encouraged to provide descriptions and photos of the completed projects, so they can be featured in The Anchor. Along with poster board describing project and photo's at the 2023 Annual Meeting.
